

## WHAT DOES RESTRICTED REGULAR OPERATION MEAN FOR THE FACILITY?

- All children once again visit the facility.
- The children are once again looked after in their familiar core groups; this also means that siblings are sometimes no longer in one group.
- The core groups in the facility are generally the same size as before corona.
- If possible, the children are supervised for the "usual" number of hours, especially the children who were previously cared for under the skeleton service. Limitations may be necessary due to a lack of staff.
- The scope of care should not be reduced for children whose day-care visit is anchored in a protection concept (child welfare), as well as in special cases of hardship.
- In addition, working legal guardians should be given priority when assigning childcare services.
- Cross-group offers and open concepts cannot be implemented at the moment, i.e. cross-group offers for preschool children are not possible.
- Where possible, the groups should be looked after separately from each other in the respective group rooms (and differentiation rooms).

- If sanitary facilities are necessarily used by more than one group, planned uses (e.g. washing hands together before eating) must be scheduled for different times.
  Of course, the facilities can be used "as required", even by two children from different groups.
- Short-term encounters of children from different groups in the hallways have no further consequences from an infectionchain perspective.
- If the facility has a separate room for eating ("children's restaurant"), this can be used by the groups at different times.
- All legal guardians entering the facility must wear mouth-nose protection.
- The distancing rules must be observed among specialist employees and towards the legal guardians.
- The hygiene rules must continue to be observed.
- Which children are cared for by which staff is documented daily in the facility.
- Contact should be maintained with children who are currently not attending day-care centres at the request of their parents or for health reasons.
- If possible, delivery and collection times should be spread out.
